2.4. Visas

It is responsibility of each nation or club to ensure that they have the proper documentation to enter Italy. If you require a Visa to enter Italy, please send an e-mail listing all the participants, their roles, their passport numbers and expiration dates to v.barbera@finp.it before **August 25th 2023**.

The request of a Visa support letter does not automatically grant the participation in the competition. Participation in the competition is allowed only after submitting the entries in the entry system.

2.5. Transport

2.7. Competition Fee

The competition fee is € 75 per athlete

3. SPORTS ENTRIES

3.1. Entries

- Important dates
 - Opening date: **August 8th 2023**
 - Entry Deadline: **August 23rd 2023**
- LOC accepts entries after the closing date. All late entries need to be communicated to both LOC and WPS through an email to previous contacts. An extra fee of 20% could be charged.

3.2. Competition Format and Schedule

- 1,5 km from S3 to S6
- 3 km from S7 to S10
- 3 km from S11 to S14

One set of medals for M/F for each group will be allocated based on the Italian Open Water Point System. This system has been developed according to the long course world records of 200 m freestyle (from S3 to S6) and 400 m freestyle (from S7 to S14).

3.3. Athlete Eligibility

- Swimmers must hold an active World Para Swimming license for 2023 Season.
- To compete in the **Sardinia 2023 World Para Swimming Open Water Cup**, an athlete must have an International Classification status of Review (R), Fixed Date Review (FDR) or Confirmed (C).

3.4. MQS

- No MQS are required.

3.5. Rules & Regulations

- For all open water events the current World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations apply. They can be found on the World Para Swimming website (see Swimming – Rules & Regulations – Rules).
- Fines and technical protest fees as per WPS Rules and Regulations

4. COMPETITION INFORMATION

4.1. Technical Meeting

A technical meeting will be on September 22nd (more information will be circulated later on). On this occasion, info will be given about the call area, the swimwear (caps, goggles and swimsuits) that must be from the approved list and might be checked in the call area.

5. ANTI-DOPING AND MEDICAL INFORMATION

5.1. Anti-Doping
